

Proskauer Wins MCCA's Thomas L. Sager Award for Diversity and Inclusion

Chairman Joe Leccese accepted the award on behalf of Proskauer at the MCCA's Diversity Gala on October 3rd, sharing the stage with the Chair of Morgan Lewis Jami Wintz McKeon. The joint win emphasized the need for collaboration across the legal industry to support the MCCA's mission to increase the pipeline of underrepresented individuals in the legal field.
